## - PUBLIC NOTICE ADOPTION AND ENTRY INTO FORCE OF REGULATIONS

Public notice is given by the undersigned, François Gagnon, clerk, to all ratepayers of the Municipality of Ormstown to the effect that the by-laws listed below were adopted at the regular meeting of the municipal council held on Monday, May 2, 2022. These regulations therefore enter into force at the time of publication of this notice, namely May 4, 2022.

- By-law n° 80-2022 Ethics and deontology of municipal employees.
- By-law n° 140-2022 Tariffs for non-resident road accident victims on Ormstown territory

The By-law on ethics and professional conduct (n° 80-2022), as prescribed by law, aims to revise and replace before May 5, 2022 any previous by-law adopted by the Municipality. It contains rules relating to the values and conduct of employees aimed at recognizing, on the one hand, the superior interests of the Municipality and, on the other hand, rules aimed at ensuring impartiality in decision-making, the respect for values and the rules of conduct to be adopted.

As for By-law **No. 140-2022**, based on the principle that it is not up to the taxpayers of Ormstown to assume the costs for accident victims requiring the intervention of the Fire Safety Service (SSI) for non-residents, it provides for a pricing to be sent to the owner of the vehicle so that the latter claims the invoice from his insurer

Anyone interested in any of these by-laws can read them at the Municipality's office, at 5 rue Gale and during regular office hours, between 9:00 a.m. and 12:00 p.m. or, ideally given the precautionary measures made necessary by COVID-19 by consulting it on the Municipality's website at www.ormstown.ca.
