



PUBLIC NOTICE

FILING AND PRESENTATION OF DRAFT REGULATIONS

Public notice is given by the undersigned, François Gagnon, clerk, to all ratepayers of Ormstown to the effect that the following draft by-laws were filed and presented at the regular council meeting held on May 2, 2022, which are scheduled to be adopted, with or without change, at the regular meeting of the municipal council on Monday, June 6, 2022 or, failing that, at any other subsequent meeting:

- **Draft Regulation No. 139-2022 on the use of pesticides and other chemical substances.**
- **Draft By-law No. 8-2022 on the remuneration of elected municipal officials.**
- **Draft By-law No. 2-2022 on the internal management and the procedure of the assembly of the municipal council.**

These regulations aim, for the first (**Regulation No. 139-2022**) to ensure the protection of public health by governing the use of pesticides, by providing for certain prohibitions and control measures so as to reduce adverse effects.

For the second (**By-law No. 8-2022**), it is only intended to provide for the remuneration of elected officials for working sessions to advance files, take orientations or others, the pricing being the same as for a committee meeting. It is therefore an addition, the regulations in force being silent on this subject.

Finally, with regard to internal management and assembly procedure (**By-law No. 2-2022**), it aims to prohibit, in an election year, any substantial financial commitment of 2 years or more binding the council to come in November.

Anyone interested in any of these by-laws can read them at the Municipality's office, at 5 rue Gale and during regular office hours, between 9:00 a.m. and 12:00 p.m. or, ideally given the precautionary measures made necessary by the COVID-19 by consulting them on the Municipality's website.
