



**PUBLIC NOTICE
FILING AND PRESENTATION OF A DRAFT BY-LAW**

Public notice is given by the undersigned, François Gagnon, clerk, to all taxpayers of Ormstown to the effect that the following draft by-law was filed and presented at the regular council meeting held on June 6, 2022, which is scheduled to be adopted, with or without change, at the regular meeting of the municipal council on Monday, July 4, 2022, or, failing that, at any other subsequent meeting:

- Draft By-law no. 132-2022 prohibiting domestic fireworks and amending By-law no. 132-2020 on fire prevention and safety accordingly.

This regulation aims to no longer make the items mentioned available to the public and to prohibit their use. This decision is based not only on many citizen complaints received demanding peace of mind, but also with regard to the fire risks that this may entail in these modern times, given climate change (warming and drought). Ignition and fallout locations pose a fire hazard that becomes a public safety issue.
