That By-Law therefore enter into force at the time of publication of this notice, namely June 8, 2022.

- By-law no. 8-2022 on the remuneration of elected municipal officials amending By-law no. 8.6-2019 on the remuneration of elected municipal officials.

his By-law is only intended to remunerate the working sessions of elected municipal officials, these meetings allowing them to discuss current files, to participate in the overhaul of the Urban Plan and related by-laws, in particular the Zoning By-law, etc., which is not included in the 2019 By-Law. No changes have been made to the basic allowance for elected officials or to the expense allowance. That By-Law is retroactive to January 1, 2022.
