Public notice is given by the undersigned, François Gagnon, clerk, to all taxpayers of the Municipality of Ormstown to the effect that there has been adoption of the by-law below presented at the regular meeting of the municipal council held on Thursday, May 12, 2022. These rules therefore enter into force at the time of publication of this notice, namely May 17, 2022.

- By-law no. 2-2022 - Internal management and assembly procedure for council meetings.

The By-law modifies By-law 2-2021 so as to implement the objective which is not to commit the municipal council to come by the awarding of contracts, the conclusion of a memorandum of understanding, etc. for substantial and major amounts, for periods of one (1) year or more, in an election year.
