## PUBLIC NOTICE COUNCIL MEETINGS OPEN TO THE PUBLIC

The regular meeting of the municipal council on November 15, 2021, at 7:30 p.m., will be open to the public. The number of people admitted will however be very limited in order to ensure compliance with health rules. Consequently, the number of places is limited to 8 people.

## Procedure:

For the sake of fairness, those wishing to attend should:

- 1. Register in advance as of Wednesday, November 10<sup>th</sup>, starting at 12:00 p.m., by e-mail to: greffe@ormstown.ca
- 2. Have a question or a particular subject requiring a response from the municipal council and ideally include it in their email, but not necessary;
- 3. The rule of "first come, first served" will apply, the first 8 people to come forward will be officially accepted with a response by e-mail;
- 4. These 8 admitted persons are authorized to ask their question directly in front of the municipal council, an immediate answer may be given to them, but may also be postponed in the event that certain verifications are required in order to correctly answer the said question;
- 5. In the event of a question from the public for a person not admitted to the premises, this question must be submitted to the Municipality no later than 12:00 noon on the day of the meeting in accordance with the procedure applied for the last year, at the same email address: <a href="mailto:greffe@ormstown.ca">greffe@ormstown.ca</a>
- 6. For those with no questions, we thank you in advance for following the council meeting live on You Tube by clicking on the link for this purpose on the Municipality's website at <a href="https://www.ormstown.ca">www.ormstown.ca</a>, your interest in following municipal issues being appreciated.

Requests that fail to comply with the established procedure (times, dates and questions) will not be eligible.

**By-law No. 2-2021** governing the assembly procedures of the municipal council (available on the Municipality's website) notably states that:

Art. 33 The question period is maximum 30 minutes.

Art. 34 Each person has 5 minutes to ask their question and is entitled to a sub-question on the same subject.
